Wealthy Gold Coast businessman Kenton Campbell has sponsored a three-year koala research project at Blackbutt's Ironbark Station.

He and his company's software experts are spending about \$80,000 to develop a koala collar for scientists to track them in an attempt to control rising mortality rates.

"It's just a drop in the ocean really and much more will have to be done by everyone at a local and government level if we're going to save our creatures," Mr Campbell was reported to have said.
