

Zarraffa's kicks off restaurant push

SOUTHPORT-based coffee-house group Zarraffa's Coffee is on the expansion trail with plans to establish up to eight more outlets over the next 18 months.

The group, which presently operates just one outlet at Australia Fair, has just struck a five-year lease in the heart of the food precinct at Harbour Town which is taking shape at Biggera Waters.

Zarraffa's, headed by Kenton Campbell, is to occupy a 163 square metre tenancy fronting the centre's 3400-seat cinema centre.

Mr Campbell says his group plans to use the Harbour Town outlet as a nerve centre for its ambitious expansion program which will see its second store open in Brisbane before the completion of Harbour Town in mid-November.

Zarraffa's plans to open six stores in Brisbane by next year and a further one outlet on the Gold Coast.

Mr Campbell is spending \$250,000 on the fitout of the Harbour Town outlet which will incorporate the coffee shop, a viewing area for coffee roasting and administration offices for the group.
